## Hatchery laborer

To assist with the annual spring walleye egg take and walleye hatchery operations for Bemidji Area Fisheries. Assist with other fisheries work as needed.

Includes weekends and evening/nights so work hours vary. Anticipate this position to be 6 weeks of work in April/May but exact dates are dependent on seasonal conditions. \$18.18/hr.

## <u>Fish survey laborer</u>

To assist with operations for Bemidji Area Fisheries. Assist in fish production including but not limited to egg take, hatchery and stocking activities. Assist with fish survey activities. Conduct maintenance and repair of equipment and facilities.

Anticipate that the position will be from mid-April to mid-June. Typically will be 40 hrs/week Monday-Friday however will include some weekend and evening/night work hours. \$18.18/hr.

## <u>Creel Census Clerk – Cass Lake</u>

This position exists to collect statistically reliable and minimally biased data to be used for the estimation of fishing pressure, catch, harvest, and angler demographics on Cass Lake, Beltrami County during the open water season in order to assess fishing quality and fisheries management. This position has daily contact with anglers and requires strong interpersonal communication skills. This is a roving creel survey conducted by boat.

The position will be from May 10 – October 15. Will be five 8 hour shifts per pay period week (40 hrs/week) with shift times varying. You must be able to work all weekend days.

# Creel Census Night Clerk – Cass Lake

This position exists to collect statistically reliable and minimally biased data to be used for the estimation of fishing pressure, catch, harvest, and angler demographics on Cass Lake, Beltrami County during the open water season in order to assess fishing quality and fisheries management. This position has daily contact with anglers and requires strong interpersonal communication skills. This is a mainly an access based creel but does require some survey by boat.

The position will be from May 10 – September 30. Will be five 4 hour shifts per pay period week (20 hrs/week) with shift times starting approximately one hour before dark. Starts at \$18.28/hr. You must be able to work all Friday and Saturday nights.

# Creel Census Clerk – Lake Bemidji

This position exists to collect statistically reliable and minimally biased data to be used for the estimation of fishing pressure, catch, harvest, and angler demographics on Lake Bemidji, Beltrami County during the open water season in order to assess fishing quality and fisheries management. This position has daily contact with anglers and requires strong interpersonal communication skills. This is a roving creel survey conducted by boat, snowmobile and ATV.

This is a 9 month position for open water May 10 to October 15 and then ice-on conditions from early December through the end of March. Will be five 8 hour shifts per pay period week (40 hrs/week) with shift times varying. Starts at \$18.28/hr. You must be able to work all weekend days.

#### Creel Census Night Clerk – Lake Bemidji

This position exists to collect statistically reliable and minimally biased data to be used for the estimation of fishing pressure, catch, harvest, and angler demographics on Lake Bemidji, Beltrami County during the open water season in order to assess fishing quality and fisheries management. This position has daily contact with anglers and requires strong interpersonal communication skills. This is a mainly an access based creel but may require some survey by boat.

The position will be from May 10 – September 30. Will be five 4 hour shifts per pay period week (20 hrs/week) with shift times starting approximately one hour before dark. Starts at \$18.28/hr. You must be able to work all Friday and Saturday nights.
