



The Centrarchid Technical Committee Student Travel Grant



Purpose: To financially assist one student conducting centrarchid related research of interest to the Centrarchid Technical Committee (CTC) with a travel grant of \$250 from the CTC of the North Central Division (NCD) of the American Fisheries Society (AFS) to attend the Midwest Fish and Wildlife Conference.

Eligibility: The recipient of this travel award must be currently enrolled in a college or university within the NCD for an undergraduate or graduate degree program.

Selection Criteria: The Executive Committee and state and provincial representatives will evaluate applications. Applicants' selection criteria will be based on AFS involvement and their research's relevance to the mission and goals of the CTC.

Application Materials:

1. Application letter: student's name, address, telephone number, academic institution, degree, degree level, description of current research, reason for wanting to attend the Midwest Fish and Wildlife Conference, and need for financial assistance.
2. CV or Resume

Award Frequency: The CTC will select one recipient each year depending on available of funds.
